

The Mission Statement of the Pollock Pines-Camino Community Center Association is to develop, execute to completion and monitor operations of a Community Center. The objectives of the Community Center is to serve the Pollock Pines and Camino residents; organizations and groups; and to encourage and accommodate community activities.

The PPCCCA was established 25 years ago as a 501(c)3 nonprofit public benefit association and receives no outside funding or support. The Center is financially sustained through the generosity of donors, land and legacy bequeaths, membership fees, fund raisers and volunteers. The PPCCCA has no paid personnel at any level and is governed by an Executive Board of Directors...all volunteers!!

Through the El Dorado Community Foundation and the generosity of their donors, the Center was granted the Endow El Dorado grant to make the purchase and installation of the generator possible.

The installation of this generator allows the Center to become a fully self-sustaining facility. The Center is a certified Red Cross facility that will now have the capability to feed and house community residents and emergency personnel during a power outage or disaster.

It has always been and remains the patent desire of the Center to be a place of safety, security and comfort for all those that enter it's doors.

The Community Center is the central hub of communication and entertainment of its community.

The Community Center is host to over 700 activities each year beginning December 31st with New Year's Bingo. 50 Tuesday night Bingo games; 7 Friday Night Taco Fiestas;; 250 Senior Nutrition Lunches; 300 days of free bread and staples distributed to residents; 3 Free Holiday dinners; 9 Rotary Interact Kids Saturday breakfasts; host to Rib Dinners and cook-offs and special holiday events; last night party and overnight stay for Hwy 50 Assn. Wagon Train and supporting organization fund raisers, events and meetings; providing a venue for Red Cross, C.E.R.T., Fire Safe Council meetings and exercises; Scouts and Little League; Town Hall meetings; special County forums and meetings; and available for rent to the public for meetings, parties, weddings and receptions, special events and more.

As time and money allow, the Center is dedicated to becoming more energy efficient. Currently, Solar Power is a high priority, given our perfect solar position, and is being researched for cost and efficiency. Included, but not limited to, in this research, is the replacement of the high utility use and cost of standard water heaters to on-demand units; replacing and upgrading out-dated heating and cooling units; and replacement of single pane to thermal windows. Additional smaller utility demand entities that create a greater energy savings and utility costs savings are also being researched.

As in all buildings, maintenance -repairs - replacements and improvements are on-going and imperative to assure the continued integrity of the structure and assets.

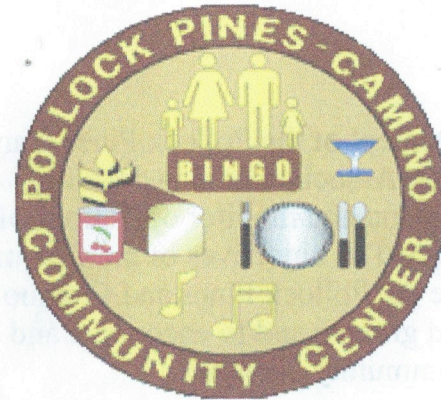

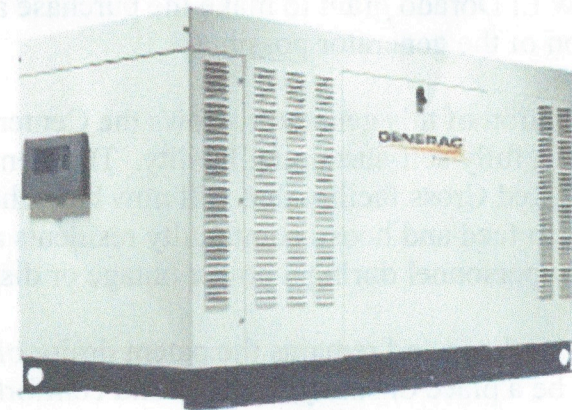
